The introduction should be sung in a recitative style, like a chant. Once into the faster tempo, the feeling of 6/8 may be alternated with 3/4, at the conductor's discretion. Generally the piece should be very rhythmic and *non legato*, with the exception of bars 91-106 and bars 122-133.

The Sanskrit text of *Gate gate* which appears at the end of the *Prajñaparamita Heart Sutra* is generally regarded as the essence of Buddhist teaching. *Gate* means gone. Gone from suffering to the liberation of suffering. Gone from forgetfulness to mindfulness. Gone from duality to non-duality. *Gate gate* means gone, gone. *Paragate* means gone all the way to the other shore. Gone, gone, gone all the way over. In *Parasamgate*, *sam* means everyone, the entire community of beings. Everyone gone over to the other shore. *Bodhi* is the light inside, enlightenment, or awakening. And *svaha* is a cry of joy or excitement, like "Hallelujah!" Gone, gone, gone all the way over, everyone gone to the other shore, enlightenment, *svaha!*

As a composer, Brian has composed music for film, television, theatre, and the concert hall and his music has been performed around the world, including a recent premiere of *Voca me* by the Vancouver Chamber Choir. *Gate, gate* has just been released on a British Columbia Boy's Choir CD. Brian currently has a part-time position at Studio 58, Langara College's professional theatre school, where he teaches singing and directs the choir. He is also the founder and music director of the Vancouver Actor's Chorus and frequently gives workshops on music for corporations as well as performers, students, and teachers.
